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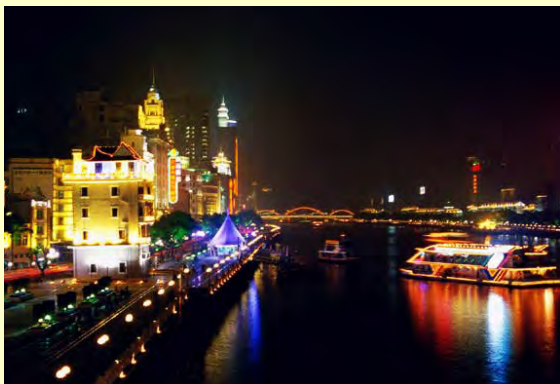

Acceptance of Papers

The acceptance of presentations is based on review of the submitted extended abstracts. The notification of acceptance along with instructions for the preparation of papers and the template of manuscript will be forwarded to the prospective authors by November 15, 2010. The manuscripts should be typed in accord with the recommended format and are required to be mailed to secretariats by March 31, 2011.
